The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) is making available \$111,516,000 in CDBG-DR funding to local governments impacted by Hurricane Michael through the Rebuild Florida General Infrastructure Repair Program – Round II. This public notice is to solicit citizen comments on the proposed application for the City of Bristol. The City of Bristol will submit one project for consideration under this round of funding which is detailed below:

Wastewater, Potable Water and Stormwater Repairs and Improvements (Estimated Grant Request: \$6,864,000.00)

This project will make improvements to wastewater, potable water and stormwater infrastructure located in a low-and-moderate

income area within the City of Bristol that was impacted by Hurricane Michael. The project includes conversion of a force main system to a gravity system to create a more resilient wastewater system that functions even in the absence of power. In addition, the project will rehabilitate and elevate potable water tanks that were damaged by Hurricane Michael to ensure their resiliency in the future. Finally, the project will make repairs to stormwater infrastructure that was damaged during debris removal efforts related to Hurricane Michael and is now creating flooding problems at the new replacement high school built after Hurricane Michael.

The City of Bristol does not anticipate that anyone will be displaced because of the CDBG-DR funded activities proposed above. If persons are displaced because of the planned activities, the City of Bristol will assist them as described in the County's anti-displacement and relocation policy, which is available for review at Bristol City Hall located at: 12444 NW Virginia G.
